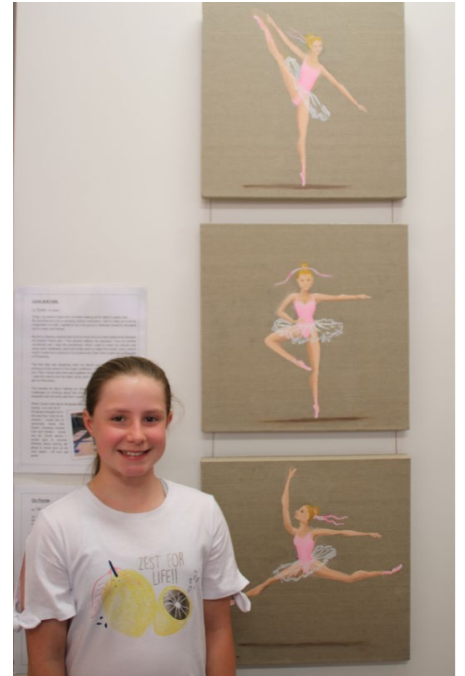
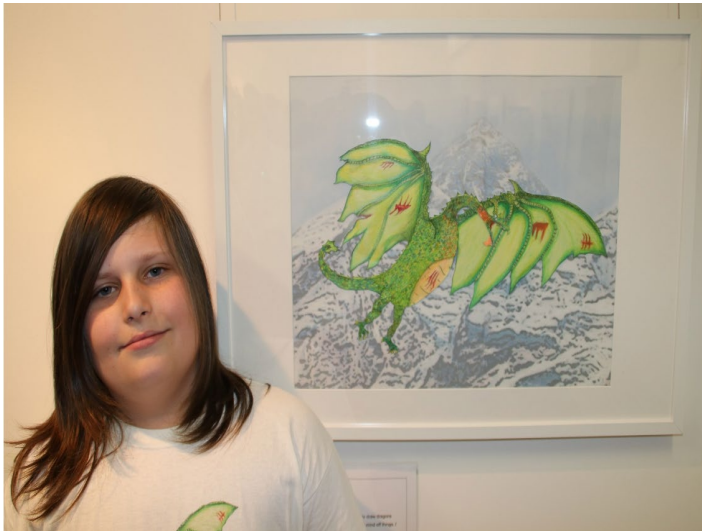

Rules of the Crossing

Schools can be busy places before and after school. There are often a lot of people all trying to cross the road at the same time. The Addison Street and Mary Street entrances have a crossing guard before and after school to ensure the safety of students. As some students do not have an adult who walks them across the road, the crossing person helps all people. If you are approaching the crossing with your child or you have a child that uses the crossing can you please speak to them about the safe use of these spaces.

- At each crossing there is a yellow line on each side of the road. We ask all people wanting to cross the road to remain behind the yellow line.
- The crossing guard will walk to the middle of the crossing.
- When it is safe and they have ensured that all traffic has stopped, they will ask the wanting pedestrians to cross the road.
- Please remain on the crossing
- Walk across the road from one side to the other
- Be mindful of the people crossing the road
- If you are riding a bike, dismount from the bike and walk the bike across the road. Do not resume riding the bike until it is safe to do so.

These rules are designed to keep everyone safe when using the crossing.

Opal Cards

To ride on the school bus, students must have a valid Opal Card. Ensure that your child has their Opal Card when they intend to travel on the bus. The bus company has informed us that they will be monitoring the use of Opal Cards over the next couple of weeks. 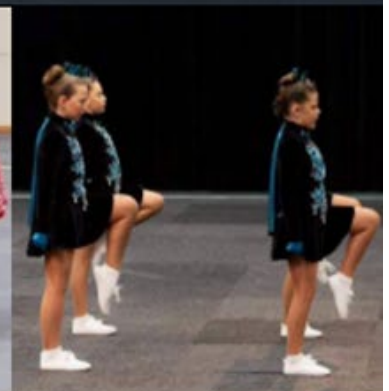


