



## Year 6 Leadership Camp

Dear parent/carer

This year we will be holding the Year 6 Leadership Camp from **Thursday, 6 to Friday, 7 February 2020**. The camp will be held on the grounds of Shellharbour Public School, utilising the grassed area for camping, COLA and hall for activities. Students will participate in a variety of structured learning experiences including team building activities, peer leadership workshops, growth mindset workshops and Student Parliament activities led by Stage Three teachers.

Students will camp overnight in three person tents followed by activities at school on Friday. Students can wear casual clothing to school on Thursday evening and can wear mufti on Friday. This is a terrific opportunity for our senior students to learn the importance of working cohesively.

Students will attend school on Thursday and are required to go home at 2:55 pm. This will allow them an opportunity to refresh and shower and be dropped back at school at 5:30 pm on Thursday evening. Students will be collected from school as usual on Friday at 2:55 pm. Students are to be dropped off and collected from their classroom.

Students are not required to wear school uniform however, must wear enclosed shoes. They will need to bring the following items: **(all items are to be clearly labelled)**

- A hat, sunscreen and insect repellent
- A pillow and pillowcase and sleeping bag
- A portable mattress (with pump if required) or camp mat
- Wet weather gear as well as a warm jacket/jumper for night time activities
- Pyjamas and slip on shoes/thongs (for late night bathroom visits)
- Toiletries
- Change of clothes for Friday (not school uniform)
- Torch
- Bowl, plate, cup and spoon
- Tea towel (for washing up the dishes)

Students are NOT to bring:

- Digital devices, including iPods, cameras, phones, etc
- Foods containing nuts or nut products due to allergies
- Jewellery
- Hairdryers and hair straighteners

Mrs Mosley and Stage Three teachers will be camping overnight with the children. Students will be supervised by Shellharbour Public School staff. The cost of the camp is **\$10.00 per child**, which covers the cost of dinner on Thursday night, breakfast Friday morning as well as morning tea and lunch on Friday. If you would like your child to participate in this activity, which has been approved by the Principal, please complete the attached forms and return with payment of \$10.00 by **Tuesday, 4 February 2020**.
