Dear parents and carers

Life Ed NSW delivers programs in various environments, including the famous mobile learning centre - the **Life Education Van**. The van will visit our school from Tuesday, 27 August to Thursday, 29 August 2024.



Life Ed teaches children and young people aged 3-13 the health, safety and wellbeing skills. This is so students can make better decisions throughout their lives, creating a holistic impact on their long-term health. Life Education makes a difference by delivering evidence-backed, engaging education to children in their formative years, to build the skills they need to make safer and healthier choices. Life Ed empowers our children to achieve this through preventative health education.

The programs are delivered by a team of specially trained educators and supported by tune-in lessons prior to the visit and a series of post-visit resources. It is the aim of Life Education NSW and Shellharbour Public School for every child to attend the program. The programs address many of the components and objectives within the NSW PDHPE curriculum.

The cost for this in-school visit is **\$7** per student.

- When:** Tuesday, 27 August to Thursday, 29 August 2024
- Time:** 1-hour lessons within school time
- Where:** Shellharbour Public School playground
- Requirements:** Students are expected to be safe, respectful and responsible throughout the lesson
- Supervision:** Class teachers will supervise. Supervising teachers have recognised and current training in emergency care and CPR.
